

Bylaw Update

- Last bylaw update approved by the membership in May 2016
- Current Revision Process:
 - Small revision proposed in January 2022
 - Over last 6 months, the Bylaw Committee sought input from:
 - Executive Committee
 - Workgroup Chairs
 - Members
- Process required for updates



Overview of Proposed Changes

- Removes requirement for Committee/Workgroup Chair be EC member
- Minor updates to language to assure current practice and structure are reflected
- President will chair EC & General Membership Meetings
- Reorganization of Committees & Workgroups
 - Formal addition of Workforce Development

- Modified Organizational Structure
 - 1. Current Executive Committee renamed to Board of Directors
 - Removes Past President Role as Officer – increases At Large members to 13
 - 3. Addition of newly organized EC (9 BOD Members)
 - Appointed by BOD annually
 - Pres, Pres-Elect, Vice Pres, Treasurer, Secretary, Past Pres & 3 BOD members
 - 4. Creation of Forums to meet unique needs of members

Next Steps

- 1. Executive Committee reviews changes
- 2. Bylaw Committee creates final draft
- 3. October 21st EC meeting vote on proposed changes
- IF APPROVED Final draft shared with General Membership by 10/26/22
- General Membership to vote at Annual Meeting at League on 11/16/22
- 6. IF APPROVED, changes effective as of 11/16/22
