Enhancing Local Public Health Infrastructure

- Reporting Deadlines – 10th of month
 - Q6 Progress Reports
 - March Expense Reports
- No Cost Extension approved – grant period ends 6/30/25
 - Amendment Letters sent via Submittable on March 19th
- Budget Modifications
 - Submit by April 30th
 - Reimbursement in next grant year will not be approved without a modification

Sustaining Local Public Health Infrastructure

- NJACCHO applying to facilitate award
- Grant available starting 4/12 via SAGE – NJACCHO ONLY
- Anticipated allocations for LHDs - \$165,000
 - Contingent on number of LHDs who apply
 - Project period – 7/1/24 – 3/31/26
 - Funds expected to be available all up front
