JOB DESCRIPTION:

As part of a training program, assists Registered Environmental Health Specialists in conducting sanitary, environmental, and public health inspections; does related work as required. As a trainee and productive worker, you will be learning to inspect homes, retail food establishments and noting violations of sanitary and health laws. Learns to investigate nuisances and violations relevant to sanitary, environmental and public health laws, rules and ordinances. Conversely, all duties performed on the job may not be listed. Will be required to learn and utilize various types of electronic and/or manual recording and computerized info systems used by the agency, office or related units.

REQUIREMENTS:

Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree including a minimum of thirty-two (32) credits in the biological sciences, physical sciences, environmental sciences, or mathematics or any combination. Note: Appointees are required to obtain a valid license as a Registered Environmental Health Specialist issued by the NJ Dept. of Health & Senior Services, prior to appointment to the primary title, Sanitary Inspector. Must possess a valid driver's license.
