

Report to NJACCHO on PHACE – May 2023

PHACE is still working to develop by-laws for the newly incorporated 501 c 3 organization.

PHACE has and continues to advocate for the passage of Senate Bill 2413 and Assembly Bill 4115 which would assure a minimum of \$10 million dollars is budgeted annually for Public Health Priority Funds.

PHACE, with NJACCHO sponsored a statewide spring meeting funded by the workforce development grant on foundational public health services and the future of public health in New Jersey. We had a great turnout, especially from disciplines other than Health Officers, and attendees were very happy. This is intended to be a kickoff of our 21C efforts around Foundational Public Health Services and Capabilities and a follow-up meeting is already scheduled.
