GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Reports to the Assistant Commissioner; Administers and manages the Communicable Disease Service (CDS). This position is responsible for the overseeing all activities related to the Infectious and Zoonotic Disease Program, Vaccine Preventable (Immunization) Program, and the Regional Epidemiology Program. Directs staff on implementing all key activities within the three program areas. Establishes policies to ensure that Department procedures are being followed. Developes budgets and financial planning for the Service, including state and federal funding partners. Acts as the lead and/or Pricipal Investigator on mutliple federal awards including the a Service Area's robust COVID 19 Pandemic portfolio, provides overarching direction/coordination to the Service Area's activities realted to the Pandemic. Addresses the Service's mission and goals, relating to the current health issues in the State, targeted high-risk groups. Oversees a service wide communication network to disseminate accurate and consistent information to the public and healthcare providers regarding health-related issues in the State of New Jersey. Provides overall direction of CDS activities to ensure the Department's goals and objectives are met.

REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

EDUCATION: Graduation from and accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Five (5) years of experience in the administration and management of a program to develop and implement policy in a public or private organization.
