GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Reports to the Assistant Commissioner; Administers and manages the Consumer, Environmental and Occupational Health Service (CEOHS) comprising three major program areas: Environmental and Occupational Health Assessment, Environmental and Occupational Health Surveillance and Public Health and Food Protection. Directs staff on implementing all key activities within the three program areas. Establishes policies to ensure that Department procedures are being followed. Prepares financial, legislative and regulatory reports. Provides direction in the development, adoption, and enforcement of regulations. Provides direction to ensure program goals and activities reflect the state-of-the-science to protect public health. Responsible for budgeting, planning and executing grants, cooperative agreements and Memorandum of Agreements with State and Federal agencies. Work collaboratively with other DOH programs on overlapping and mutually beneficial goals for the protection of public health. Provides overall direction of CEOHS activities to ensure the Department's goals and objectives are met.

REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

REQUIREMENTS:

EDUCATION: A Bachelor's degree from and accredited college or university is required. An advanced degree in management, administration, or other areas related to the particular position.

EXPERIENCE: Five (5) years of supervisory/managerial experience and a variety of management experiences and organizational responsibilities.

NOTE: Successful completion of the Certified Public Managers (CPM) Program will be a factor in selection. Participating in any portion of the CPM program or related programs would be helpful.

Evidence of major professional accomplishments is required, as is demonstrated ability in communication and leadership skills.

Demonstrated managerial skills, including such factors as inter-personal skills, decision-making, problem analysis and creative thinking, administrative judgment, delegation, managerial, or financial control, interdepartmental cooperation/liaison, development of subordinates and organizational awareness are required.

Specific requirements may be waived by the Commissioner of Personnel with sufficient justification.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform essential duties of the position.
